Prayer Focus – NEPAL

United Mission to Nepal (UMN) has been continuing to help people affected by the severe floods in the Tarai regions of Nepal a few months ago. Shortly before Christmas, a team from UMN distributed warm clothes, blankets, mattresses, bed-sheets and pillows to 179 family members from 42 households in Musahar village of Pratappur Rural Municipality, in Rupandehi. This settlement is one of the flood-affected villages and is amongst the poorest in the entire ward. The Musahars are also an extremely marginalised group in the society as they fall very low in the caste hierarchy. **Give thanks** that UMN are able to provide assistance to those in need. **Pray** for those in Nepal who are continuing to rebuild their homes and livelihoods following last year's floods or the 2015 earthquakes.
